B-IACM Quarterly report, Q1, 2020

Introduction:


B-IACM has been a cornerstone strategy for the national HIV program. With the objective of B-IACM to leverage existing strategies and approaches for case detection, immediate ART enrolment and retention in HIV care to achieve the global 95-95-95 targets by 2025.

B-IACM was initiated in 2014 in Siem Reap and Battambang provinces and scaled up to 20 provinces (51 operational districts) by March, 2020.


COVERAGE of B-IACM implementation, Q1, 2020 (20 provinces: 51 ODs)



B-IACM cascade Q1, 2020 (20 provinces: 51 ODs)




According to B-IACM approach, the 1st quarter of 2020 data shows that there were 870 reactive cases of HIV in health centers and communities over the past three months. Of these, 837 reactive cases came for the confirmatory test at VCCT (96.20%), among the confirm test at VCCT, there 825 were positive and 789 were enrolled in ART services (95.63%).



Total numbers of reactive HIV cases by client types, Q1, 2020

Among 870 with a reactive result, of **58% (N=502)** were a general population, follow by **MSM is 24%** (**N=212**) followed by TG: 5 % (N=48) and HIV+ partners were 5% (N=42).

Challenges: By verifying the data reported in the B-IACM Database and the P4R report, found that the P4R report were about 34 cases higher than data in B-IACM databases. The difference is due to some ODs without CMA contract did not entry the data to database routinely and send data to NCHADS, as well as some provinces computers are old do not support with new version of B-IACM Data base (Ex: OD Poipet, Thamor Pouk, Preahnet Preas and OD Kong Pisey) and No computers for CMA for new site for install B-IACM database, CMA turned over (Poipet OD, BMC province).

Solutions: To tackle with an issue, B-IACM team has been contacting each OD for verification. Additionally, the programmer will also look at all codes used to extract data from the database. Doing so, we do expect the problem will solve. B-IACM team updated B-IACM database include HIV risk assessment then will update the new version for B-IACM database for CMC, CMA accordingly.
