B-IACM Quarterly report, Q2, 2020

Introduction:


B-IACM has been a cornerstone strategy for the national HIV program. With the objective of B-IACM to leverage existing strategies and approaches for case detection, immediate ART enrolment and retention in HIV care to achieve the global 95-95-95 targets by 2025.

B-IACM was initiated in 2014 in Siem Reap and Battambang provinces and scaled up to 20 provinces (51 operational districts) by March, 2020.


COVERAGE of B-IACM implementation, Q2, 2020 (20 provinces: 51 ODs)



B-IACM cascade Q2, 2020 (20 provinces: 51 ODs)




According to B-IACM approach, the 2rd quarter of 2020 data shows that there were 845 reactive cases of HIV in health centers and communities over the past three months. Of these, 827 reactive cases came for the confirmatory test at VCCT (98.54%), among the confirm test at VCCT, there 815 were positive and 791 were enrolled in ART services (97.05%).



Total Numbers of reactive HIV Cases by types, Q2, 2020

Among 845 with a reactive **result, of 53% (**N=446) were a general population, follow by MSM **is 28%** (N= 238) followed by TG: 7 % (N=54), Pregnant Woman: **5** %(N=44) and HIV+ partners were **4%** (N=35).

Challenges: By verifying the data reported in the B-IACM Database and the P4R report; found that the P4R report were about 34 cases higher than data in B-IACM databases. The difference is due to some ODs without CMA contract (Thamor Pouk, Preahnet Preas, OD Kong Pisey) and CMA turned over I Poipet OD, then CMA has just recruited, BMC province.

Solutions: To tackle with an issue, B-IACM team has been contacting each OD for verification. Additionally, the programmer will also look at all codes used to extract data from the database. NCHADS will conducted the refresher training on update B-IACM tool and database in September, 2020 to improve the B-IACM data quality.
