B-IACM Quarterly report, Q4, 2019

Introduction:


B-IACM has been a cornerstone strategy for the national HIV program. With the objective of B-IACM to leverage existing strategies and approaches for case detection, immediate ART enrolment and retention in HIV care to achieve the global 95-95-95 targets by 2025.

B-IACM was initiated in 2014 in Siem Reap and Battambang provinces and scaled up to 20 provinces (51 operational districts) by December, 2019.




COVERAGE of B-IACM implementation, Q4, 2019 (20 provinces: 51 ODs)

B-IACM cascade Q4, 2019 (20 provinces: 51 ODs)




According to B-IACM approach, the 4th quarter of 2019 data shows that there were 824 reactive cases of HIV in health centers and communities over the past three months. Of these, 813 reactive cases came for the confirmatory test at VCCT (98.5%), among the confirm test at VCCT, there 781 were positive and 754 were enrolled in ART services (96.54%).

Among 829 with a reactive result, of **57% (N=471)** were a general population, follow by **MSM is 25%** (*among 202 cases mostly from Phnom Penh is 120 cases, Battambang: 29 cases Siem Reap: 26 cases, Banteymeanchey 11 cases and the rest is from other provinces*) followed by HIV+ partners were 6% (N=46) and 4 % (N=36) were TG.

B-IACM Q3, 2019 report by 20 provinces (51 ODs)

Challenges: By verifying the data reported in the B-IACM Database and the P4R report, found that the P4R report were about 172 cases higher than data in B-IACM databases. The difference is due to some ODs without CMA contract did not entry the data to database routinely and send data to NCHADS, as well as some provinces computers are old do not support with new version of B-IACM Data base (Ex: Kampong Cham, and Moung Russey OD, ect..) and No computers for CMA for new site for install B-IACM database, CMA turned over (Poipet OD, BMC province and Thamorkul OD, Battambang province).

Solutions: To tackle with an issue, B-IACM team has been contacting each OD for verification. Additionally, the programmer will also look at all codes used to extract data from the database. Doing so, we do expect the problem will solve. Work with partners to find the computers to support some ODs for installed B-IACM database.
