I. Introduction:


B-IACM has been a cornerstone strategy for the national HIV program. With the objective of B-IACM to leverage existing strategies and approaches for case detection, immediate ART enrolment and retention in HIV care to achieve the global 95-95-95 targets by 2025.

B-IACM was initiated in 2014 in Siem Reap and Battambang provinces and scaled up to 25 provinces (56 operational districts) by September, 2020.

The Group of Champoin(GoC), has play very important role in coordinating and networking for implementation of Boostsed Integrated Active Case Management.(B-IACM) As the member of GoC, the Case Management Coordinator (CMC) and Case Management Assistant (CMA), have actively work in routine for collecting data and record in database.


II. B-IACM Coverage.


The B-IACM coverage ar in 25 provinces (56 ODs) as March, 2021



III. Program Achievement.


The B-IACM HIV cascade of quarter 1, 2021. Based on data send by CMCs, (Case Management Coordinator), CMAs, (Case Management Assistant) from 25 provinces (56 ODs), There were 895 of new HIV cases detected (new reactive cases) during this Quarterly Report covering period from 1 January to 31 March 2021). Among those reactive cases came for the confirmatory test with positive result at VCCT were 876 (97,88%). There were 844 (96,35%) HIV patients enrolled at ART services.






The among of 895 with a reactive result, of 58% (N=423) were a general population, follow by MSM is 30% (N= 265) followed by TG: 9 % (N=81), Entertainment Worker(EW): 5% (N=42), HIV partners: 3% (N=29), Pregnant Woman: 3 % (N=27) , TB patient: 1% (N=11), PWUP: 1% (N=5), and PWID: was null with 0% (N=2).

The chart below shows the Risk Screening from January-March 2021. 25 provinces. (56 ODs)



The chart shows the number of HIV positive case among the 25 provinces, (56 ODs) from January to March 2021. The Phnom Penh was the highest number of HIV positive, following by Siem Reap, Battambang, Banteay Meanchey, et and Mondulkiri is no HIV positive case.



IV. Chanllenges.

Although all activities have been implemented and achieved in this quarter, some issues have hampered the implementation of this strategy, including

• The B-IACM has been scaling up covering the national wide in 25 provinces with 56 ODs, but GFATM grant 2021-2023 did not approved for B-IACM/P4R activities.

- Some of OD sites, the computers are old which it is run slow and do not support with new version of B-IACM Data base and There are no computer in the new sites, especially in 5 new site provinces, Kep, Kratie, Stung Treng, Rattanakiri and Mondulkiri.
- The Workshop on reviewing on progress of ACM implementation, was plan to conduct in Kampong Cham on 4-5 March, 2021 had been postponed because of 20 Feb Covid 19 in Community.
- The Refrsher Training on B-IACM Database planed in March 2021 had been cancelled due to the panderpic of Covid 19 in the community.

٧. Moving forward.

The B-IACM Team will conduct the workshop and refresher training on B-IACM toll and database to improve the data quality and as well the strengthening support on GoC management for 25 provinces in 56 ODs.

The B-IACM Team will be ongoing to provide technical support as indicated in the following:

- Provide technical support to selected ODs especially new sites. sites (Kep, Kratie, Stung Treng, Rattanakiri and Mondulkiri).
- Provide ongoing on-site coaching by phone call or online to CMCs, CMAs (new and old) on how to perform data entry,
- Refresher training on B-IACM database and tool
