PREP SERVICE LAUNCHING IN KAMPONG CHAM PROVINCE

The National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STD (NCHADS) with financial support from DFAT through UNAIDS and technical support from EpiC project, working closely with a community-based organization (CBOs) organized a PrEP service launching event in Kampong Cham province. This is the 14th site of PrEP service in national HIV program. The PrEP service is delivered at family health clinic (FHC) of the provincial hospital to offer service to clients especially key population (KPs) in the province to contribute to the target of the epidemic control by keeping negative KPs staying negative and findings new HIV cases.

This event was participated by representative from NCHADS, Provincial Health Department, Provincial AIDS and STD Program, FHC service providers, Community-based organization and KP from community all around 40 people.



The objective of the launch was to inform KPs and relevant stakeholders on the availability of PrEP service and to promote access to PrEP service as well as ensure PrEP service is well functioning in the Kampong Cham province. The PrEP launching event starts with the opening from honorable guesses including KP community representative, PHD, UNAIDS and Deputy Director of NCHADS.

The whole PrEP launching event was live on 10 different Facebook pages such as: NCHADS/Care & Treatment, kapeakh, KHANA Cambodia, Men's Health Cambodia, MstyleKhmer, MET Loar page, I Am Me and More, SMARTgirl, Srey Sros Khmer and EQHA.
