CONSULTATIVE WORKSHOP ON THE REVIEW OF PREP IMPLEMENTATION

September 14-15, 2022

The National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STD (NCHADS) with financial support from WHO and EpiC and technical support from EpiC project, invited 80 participants (PASP, RH, PrEP providers, CBOs, OWs and NGOs) in total from 4 provinces-PNP, BTB, BMC and KCM to a consultative workshop on the review of PrEP implementation September 14-15, 2022 at Sovannphum hotel, Kampong Chhnang province.

The **objectives** of event mainly focus on **1**) review the PrEP implementation progress, **2**) discuss the challenges and propose suggestions and **3**) discuss the way in which PrEP can do its best to contribute to the elimination of new HIV infection
