including the HIV testing algorithm, Antiretroviral Therapy, the cause of treatment failure, regimen switching, and the HIV Drug resistance 2021 strategy. In the evening we introduced the Drafted Outline - National Action Plan for HIV DR then discuss on strategies and finalized.

On Day 2, we showed the study on ANRS 12276 2PICAM 2013 that conduct in 13 ART site on PR inhibitor-based second line regime since at least 6 months and ANRS 12374 3DICAM study with recommendations.
