

AEM Workshop: National Baseline update

05-09 December 2022, Phnom Penh, Cambodia

HIV estimates are the center piece of strategic information, and it is crucial that HIV estimates truly reflect the current state of epidemic to inform and guide the local and national response towards the last and the most difficult miles towards ending AIDS. More than ever, Cambodia needs the updated HIV estimates that is evidence-informed and developed through transparent, consultative, participatory processes in quality assured manner. So, the National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STD with coordination from UNAIDS is organizing a workshop on updating the National HIV Estimates in Cambodia in Baitong Hotel, Phnom Penh.



The objectives of this workshop are: to discuss risks and HIV positivity rate/HIV prevalence by population, modality of reach, and age group based on the data from available program and survey data in 2022, discuss and update the population size of key populations based on data triangulation from multiple sources of data, update national AEM baseline with newly available data from program, survey and other sources, update national spectrum file using AEM incidence import from the updated AEM baseline and document data assumption, adjustments, and data triangulation for AEM update, and AEM-spectrum linked processes.



This workshop is conducted in both face to face and virtually with the participation from honorable guests such as Dr. Ouk Vichea, NCHADS director, Dr. Patricia Ongpin, UNAIDS country director, Dr. Steve Wignall, Technical Director of EpiC-FHI360, Dr. Wiwat and others participant for development partners in country.
