Training Health Post on HIV and ARV in Closed Setting (ART Satellite Site)

Training Health Post on HIV and ARV in closed settings (ART Satellite Site) which conducted by NCHADS, GDP and CRS funded by Global Fund on September 26th- 28th 2023 at Provincial Health Department, Kampot Province. The objective of training is to:

- 1. To orientation on standard operation procedure support for the Implementation of Prevention, Care, and Treatment of HIV/AIDS in close settings
- 2. To improve and strengthen access to quality of HIV, STI, and HIV/TB for prevention, care, treatment, and support of people in closed settings.
- 3. To improve and strengthen referral mechanism for HIV-related services in closed settings.
- 4. To improve re-engagement of PLHIVs in ART service after release to the communities.

The workshop started with the following remark by Dr. Noy Prorphea, HIV Project Manager of CRS, Dr. Tann Chheng, Deputy Director Kampot Provincial Health Department, Dr. Ouk Vichea Director of National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STI and opening remark by His Excellency Dr. Lim Sokha, Deputy Director of Directorate General of Prisons (GDP) of Ministry of Interior. A total of 46 participants consists of 6 ART service provider from 6 provinces, 16 health post officers from 8 closed settings, officers of CRS, and officers of AUA.

There are key sessions during this training such as, 1) Presentation on SoP support for the Implementation of Prevention, Care, and Treatment of HIV/AIDS, in close settings 2) Presentation SoP ART Sites Satellite, 3) Basic knowledge on HIV/AIDS, U=U and viral load testing and result,



- 4) Knowledge on ARV treatment, 5) Basic counseling on ARV, 6) Basic need of detainees PLHIV,
- 7) Health checklist to detainee PLHIV, 8) ARV requesting flow, and 9) Data reporting and recording.
