



PrEP Service Launching at Pailin province

December 18, 2023 | Pailin Provincial Health Department, Pailin Province.

The National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STD (NCHADS) with funding support from UNAIDS Cambodia and technical assistance from EpiC project of FHI-360, working closely with a community-based organization (CBOs) organized a PrEP service launching event in Pailin province. This is the 40th site of PrEP service in national HIV program. The PrEP service is delivered at ART site of the provincial hospital to offer service to clients especially key population (KPs) in the province to contribute to the target of the epidemic control by keeping negative KPs staying negative and findings new HIV cases.

The objective of the launch was to inform KPs and relevant stakeholders on the availability of PrEP service and to promote access to PrEP service as well as ensure PrEP service is well functioning in the Pailin province. This event was participated by representative from NCHADS, Provincial Health Department, Provincial AIDS and STD Program, ART service providers, Community-based organization and KP from community all around 40 people.
