



Semi-Annual Meeting to Review the Progress and challenges of PrEP implementation

The National Center for HIV/AIDS, Dermatology and STD (NCHADS) with funding support from UNAIDS Cambodia and technical assistance from EpiC project of FHI-360 has conducted the semi-annual meeting to review the progress and challenges of PrEP implementation in Cambodia at Siem Reap province (group 1) from

December 11-12, 2023 and at Kampot province (group 2) on December 14-15, 2023. The two days meeting and aiming at updating the status of PrEP implementation and challenges, sharing the experiences of best practices of PrEP implementation in each site, discussing on demand generation and developing the improvement plan.



The 1st group meeting were participated by PASP, PDMO, facility PrEP providers, CBO PrEP providers, KHANA, RHAC, MHC, MHSS, CWPD representative and OWs with 75 participants in total from 8 provinces such as Banteay Meanchey, Battambang, Kampot, Kampong Cham, Tbong Khmum, Kampong Thom, Pailin and Phnom Penh while the 2nd group were invited the 65 participants in total from other 8 provinces-Preah Sihanouk, Kampong Speu, Kampong Chhnang, Phnom Penh, Kandal, Takeo, Siem Reap and Pursat provinces where PrEP initiative is currently implementing.



The event was successfully hosted, updated from national program, actively interacted and discussed between presenters, PASP, PrEP providers and OWs and shared the best lesson learnt and experiences during the two days workshop. In conclusion, it was such a good moment where all PrEP players from all levels met and produced the

incredible results and brought back the concrete improvement plan for each PrEP site for their six-month actions from today onwards. All participants from both groups has suggested to have this robust coordination approach in next 6 months for reviewing the implementation and contributing to end the HIV elimination by 2025.
