## I. Introduction:


Boosted Integrated Active Case Management, (B-IACM) has been a cornerstone strategy for the national HIV program. With the objective of B-IACM to leverage existing strategies and approaches for case detection, immediate ART enrolment and retention in HIV care to achieve the global 95-95-95 targets by 2025.

B-IACM was initiated in 2014 in Siem Reap and Battambang provinces and scaled up to 25 provinces (60 operational districts) by June, 2022.

The Group of Champion (GoC), has play very important role in coordinating and networking for implementation of Boosted Integrated Active Case Management. (B-IACM) As the member of GoC, the Case Management Coordinator (CMC) and Case Management Assistant (CMA), have actively work in routine for collecting data and record in database.


## II. B-IACM Coverage.

The B-IACM coverage is in 25 provinces (63 ODs)




## III. Program Achievement.


The achievement of B-IACM from January to December 2025. There were totally **4690** of new HIV cases detected (new reactive cases). With among those reactive cases, there were **4641 (98.96%)** cases have been for the confirmatory test at VCCT with positive result were **4572(98.51%)** and those **4506 (98.56%)** cases have been enrolled at ART services.




The chart below is the Reactive Cases classified by Client Type. The among of 4690, with a reactive result, of 46% (n=2158) were general population , followed by MSM 37% (n= 1712), TG: 8% (n= 391), Entertainment Worker: 3% (n= 161), Pregnant Woman: 2% (n= 106), HIV partners: 2% (n=97), TB patient: 1% (n= 26),, PWUP: 1% (n= 28), PWID 0% (n=10) and STI 0% (n=1)




The chart below shows the number of HIV Reactive Case classified by age group , from less than <15, and 15-24, 25-34, 35-49 and 50 plus. Data from January – December 2025 in 25 provinces. (63 ODs). Among the age group, the high risk age group was between 15 to 49.




With Among the Risk Screening of reactive cases, we found that clients have experienced at risk behavior were people who have sex which not using condom, followed by men who have sex with men (MSM) Partners having many sexual partners, Having sex with women, Self mobile or partners mobile, and those who having sex with men and women, and STIs, were among the top risks behaviour with putting them to HIV infection.



The chart below shows the places where people come for HIV testing. The Data from January – December 2025 in 25 provinces. (63 ODs).



The chart shows the number of HIV positive cases by province of among the 25 provinces,(63 ODs) from January to December 2025. Phnom Penh is the highest number of HIV positive cases, followed by Siem Reap, Battambang, Banteay Meanchey, Preah Sihanouk, Kandal, Kampong Spue, Takeo, , Prey Veng, Tbong Khmum, Kampong Cham, Kampong Thom, Pursat, Kampot, Kampong Chhnang, Svay Rieng, Kratie, Koh Kong, Oddor Meanchey, Stung Treng, Ratanakiri, Preah Vihear, Pailin, Mondulkiri and Kep.

- The B-IACM has been scaling up covering the national wide in 25 provinces to 63 ODs, and GFATM grant for 2024-2026 did not approved for supporting GoC Coordination Meeting at ODs and provincial level for effectively coordinating and monitoring on B-IACM Implementation to reach the 95 95 95 by 2025.
- Due to budget limitation, only 6 out of 25 provinces that have financial support for OD/PHD to conduct GoC coordination meeting with health care providers, NGOs, and relevant stakeholders to ensure the whole cascade from case finding to connecting and receiving quality of HIV related services is operated effectively.

#### Next Plan.

Plans for next reporting period including solutions to address the above constraints.

- Ongoing provides technical support to ODs especially the sites with low performance.
- Provide technical support and coordination with Group of Champion (GoC) for conducting GoC Meeting and coaching for ACM & CQI Interlink.
- Coordination with B-IACM team by Group Telegram (NCHADS/B-IACM for program implementation) and CMA/CMC Group Telegram for B-IACM database.
- Plan to conduct training on ACM tool and database to refresh for CMC and CMA, PASP and relevant stakeholders.
