The workshop was held on 8th of April 2026 at Sunway hotel. The workshop brought together approximately 43 participants, including technical experts and stakeholders from NCHADS, UNAIDS, WHO, US CDC, CHAI, EpiC/FHI 360, RHAC, KHANA, HACC, AHF, FI, CRS, CWPD, MHC, MHSS representative for community and Chhouk Sar.. The workshop aimed at to presenting the draft SOP for implementing integrated HIV interventions with mental health in Cambodia to gather additional inputs and feedback from key stakeholders for its finalization.

Presided over by **HE. Dr. Hok Kim Cheng**, General Director for Health, the Ministry of Health, the workshop opened with the remarks highlighting progress made in national HIV response, challenges remain in addressing new HIV infection, and the needs of integrated HIV, Harm Reduction and Mental Health Services for key populations and people who living with HIV (PLHIV). The meeting proceeded with a presentation of the draft SOP, followed by discussions and feedback as well as additional inputs to the draft contents of SOP.

Next action: The consultant will incorporate the feedback, suggestions and technical inputs obtained during the workshop into the final draft SOP which will be shared with the Technical Working Group (TWG) for final review and clearance before submitting it for official endorsement from the Ministry of Health.
